Essential criteria

- Experience of working within the voluntary, community and social enterprise (VCSE) sector, health sector, local government, or a related partnership environment
- Experience of influencing across organisational boundaries and of navigating complex partnerships
- Experience of delivering projects and managing competing priorities
- Experience of stakeholder engagement
- An understanding of Oxfordshire's VCSE sector and its role in improving health and wellbeing
- An understanding of partnership working within health and care systems
- An understanding of emerging policy and delivery landscapes within health and social care
- An understanding of health inequalities and the wider determinants of health
- Ability to engage confidently with a range of audiences, including senior leaders across health, social care and the community and voluntary sector, as well as with community groups and grassroots organisations
- Excellent relationship-building, communication, negotiation and influencing skills, both written and verbal
- Ability to collate and analyse information, to identify key themes and recommendations, and to prepare written reports within deadline
- Ability to work both independently and collaboratively as part of a team
- Ability to work from home with good access to broadband
- Ability to travel independently around your multi-neighbourhood cluster and the county as necessary
- Confident with Microsoft Office programmes, including Word, Excel and Teams
- Willingness to attend evening and occasional weekend meetings if necessary
